<b>Risk type</b>	Microbiological
<b>Risk description</b>	The total count of aerobic mesophilic bacteria is too high (measured value above 300 000 CFU/g). There is a risk of infection if the liquid is swallowed or comes into contact with the skin. The product does not comply with the requirements of the Toy Safety Directive.
